New series for The Grounds....

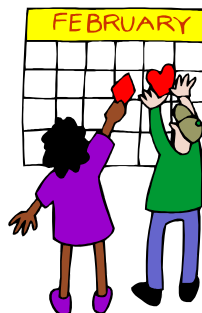
Rodney will lead a series called "Ten" starting February 26. Each week there will be a time of worship and a message, followed by table discussion of the message.

NEWS FROM MISSIONS SUPPORTED BY CCC

Jerry and Aleta Kennedy – International Missions, South Africa

The Kennedy's work with four churches: Pineland, Macassar, Bishop Lavis and Mfuleni. Pinelands and Bishop Lavis congregations are relatively new and small and have no church building. Bishop Lavis met in a home until they outgrew it and converted a two-car garage to accommodate the 30+ people who gather each week. Macassar and Mfuleni have their own buildings. Jerry shares preaching, teaching and leadership responsibilities in the churches. Aleta helps out with the Sunday school and women's ministries.

The Kennedy's are scheduled for furlough in the States in June, July and August. We hope to have them here at CCC for a report.

Village to Village – Volner Alexandre in Haiti

New projects for the year will continue to be medical trips, building of the orphanage (CCC's Thanksgiving Missions Offering 2011 was for furnishing the building) and rebuilding lives in Haiti – both spiritual and physical.

Village to Village reported that CCC donated \$10,566.08 in 2011. PTL!!!!

Jill Shaw – South Pacific Christian Fellowship, New Zealand

2011 was a good year. There were baptisms, amazing conversations that both initiated and demonstrated spiritual growth. There were retreats that challenged people to greater intimacy with God, *Faith Lifts Cafes* that created conversations that continue to bear fruit, and many other discipling and teaching opportunities. Jill visited the church planting teams in the New Zealand cities of Christchurch and Dunedin and attended a chaplaincy conference (Jill serves Massey University as a Chaplain.) She reports that NZ is 97% unchurched and most people have never been in a church building or met a Christian they liked (ouch!)
