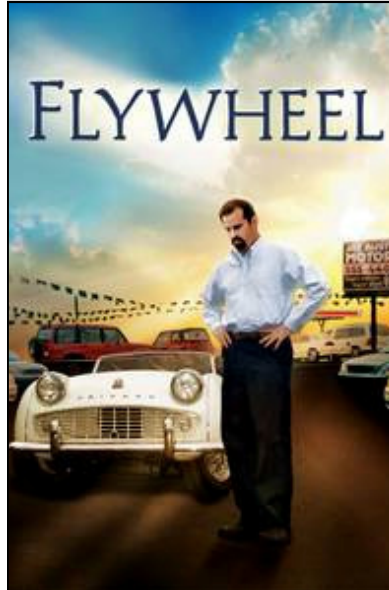

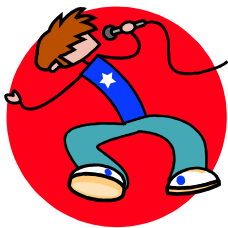
"Flywheel" is one of the series of movies produced by the Sherwood (GA) Baptist Church. Other movies include "Facing the Giants" and "Fireproof."

"Flywheel" is the story of used car salesman Jay Austin who wants to sell cars in the worst way, and does until God begins to work on him.

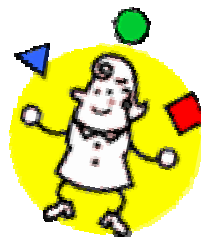

About our Giving Patterns and Needs...

The church has a number of funds that allow givers to designate their offerings to specific needs. Among them are Because We Believe and the Building Fund. At this time in our building projects some information is needed.

For five or so years we have received funds for Because We Believe. These funds have been placed in an account for the purpose of having money on hand for construction. As of the January 31, 2010, Financial Report a total of \$149,053.43 had been received. Of that amount \$105,718.16 has been disbursed for drawings, fees and construction.

A loan of \$229,456.64 has been secured from the Votaw Trust Fund of the Men for Christ. That money was also placed in the Because We Believe fund. The monthly payment on this loan is \$1,059.64.

The church has an existing mortgage with Forcht Bank for previous building funds. The balance is \$41,538.60 with a monthly payment of \$3,540.36.

Mortgage payments are made from the Building Fund. The total of the two payments is \$4,600.00. In this fiscal year (beginning September 2009) the contributions have averaged just over \$3,000 per month. Simple math shows that we are paying more than we are receiving. Rental income from the house on Lebanon Avenue helps, but the bottom line is that we are at a deficit in the Building Fund each month.

You can help.

- Maybe you did not realize our mortgage payments had already increased due to the new loan. You can help by increasing your giving to the Building Fund.
- Maybe you did not know that you need to designate a gift for the Building Fund to help pay on the mortgages. You can help by designating a regular gift for the Building Fund.
